APPROVAL TO SUBMIT 2021 SUMMER SCHOOL APPLICATION

Approval is requested to submit the 2021 PK-12 summer school application. The course offerings would include the following areas:

I. MANDATED SUMMER SCHOOL OFFERINGS

A. Graduating High School Seniors

School districts are required to offer programs for high school seniors during the summer of 2021 in order that seniors deficient in graduation credit may avail themselves of courses required for graduation prior to September, 2021. Specific course offerings will be developed as required in order to meet the individual academic needs of these students. In addition, courses will be offered to 11th graders who need to repeat a course and cannot take that course the next regular school year.

B. Standards-Based Programs for students in grades 7-12 who are “at risk” for retention and retained students.

The governing board of Los Alamitos Unified School District in accordance with state legislation shall offer summer school instructional programs for pupils enrolled in grades 7 to 12, inclusive, who were assessed as not meeting the school district's adopted standards in basic skills. Students enrolled in grades 6 to 8, inclusive, who were assessed as not meeting the school district's standards due to low mathematics, reading, or written expression scores and grades shall be offered a program of direct, systematic, and intensive supplemental instruction to allow them to achieve proficiency in standards adopted by the State Board of Education. Student attendance for those assessed as not meeting the standards is strongly recommended. The following courses will be offered in this area:

C. Intensive Instructional Programs

The governing board of Los Alamitos Unified School District in accordance with state legislation shall offer a remedial intensive instructional program for pupils enrolled in grades 2 through 9, inclusive, who were assessed as not meeting the school district's adopted standards of proficiency in basic skills, or who have been retained pursuant to specified provisions of law. Instruction shall include phoneme awareness, systematic explicit phonics and decoding, word attack skills, writing and study skills, spelling and vocabulary and explicit instruction in reading comprehension. For students in grades 4 through 9, inclusive, additional instruction will be given in the area of basic mathematical concepts, skills and applications for those not meeting standards.

II. SPECIAL EDUCATION

A. Substantially Handicapped

School districts are required to maintain an extended school year program for substantially handicapped students in grades PK-12. This program must include at least 20 instructional days for each student.
